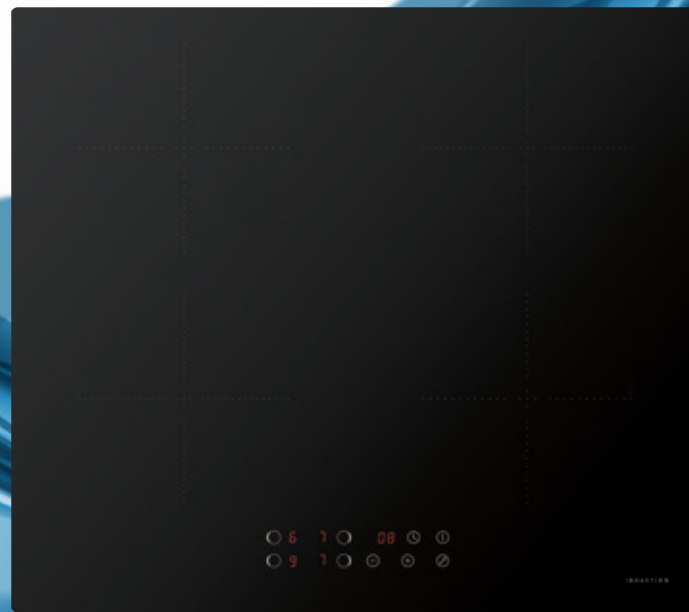
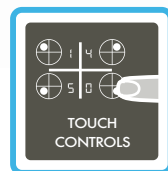

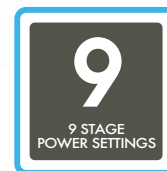

Quick Start Guide

Installing the cooktop (refer to user manual)

IMPORTANT: The cooktop must be professionally installed by a licensed electrician. See the full instruction manual for installation instructions and a few preparatory steps before first use.

Using the Cooktop

Step 1

—Refer to figure 1

To switch the cooktop on, press the Power On/Off button (A) and within 10 seconds, press the button for the cooking zone you wish to use (C).

Step 2

—Refer to figure 1

To set your desired heat level for your selected cooking zone, press the Plus or Minus buttons (B) to set the heat level (from 1 to 9, where 1 is low and 9 is high).

Step 3

Always cook your food in pans and pots that match the cooking zone diameter sizes.

Step 4

At the end of the cooking time, press the cooking zone button corresponding to the zone you wish to switch off, then press the Minus button repeatedly until the number in the heat level display reaches "0". Alternatively, you can turn off a zone by touching "-" and "+" controls together. Make sure the display shows "0". The "H" symbol (shown in Figure 2) will appear next to the cooking zone, indicating that the zone is still hot and will disappear once the heat dissipates.

Step 5:

To switch the cooktop off, press the Power On/Off button (A).

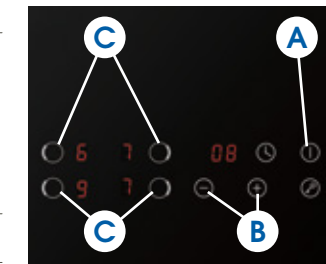

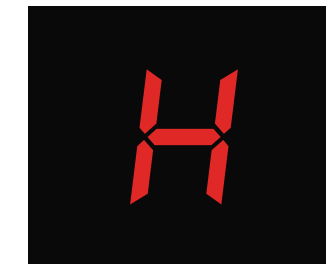
